5	<p>Matters arising from last meeting –</p> <p>a.Mill of Lyne – no further update currently.</p> <p>b.Sauchen Action Plan/Hub – meeting booked at Cluny School 7pm 5th Sept. Meeting took place with Planning & Roads at potential site area reasonably happy with site. Pre application submitted showing potential intent.</p> <p>c. Defibrillator in Sauchen – Hugh met with Westill & District Rotary Club who are happy to take charge with this and are currently looking to secure funding (£3k est.) Location remains a problem. Temp offer made to have unit at Margaret Allen Dr. In addition a maintenance fund will be required every couple of years - perhaps a local raffle fund raising event will cover this? The Rotary Club also offered a new park bench for the Sauchen Community use. We will use our Facebook page for feedback on the most appropriate location to position the bench action Hugh.</p> <p>d.Monymusk traffic issues –still awaiting feedback from the Roads Dept. who have a backlog of work due to staff shortages. Junction entrance into Monymusk Safety Improvement Matrix being developed however costs are very limited due to cut backs in funding. For information a new Chief Inspector has been appointed covering our areas.</p> <p>e.Cluny School Path – Cllr Iris Walker has spoken recently to David Smith the land owner to try and move this application forward. To avoid any further delay (when the legal paperwork is signed) we are keen to ensure that the Council have done a risk assessment as part of the design lay out approaching the Neuk entering into Sauchen Village?</p> <p>f.Cornabo Windfarm route plan design – route approved however condition 7 linked to water monitoring has not yet been fulfilled re Sepa requirements. In addition trees would need to be felled along route which is also a local concern. Community Council will continue to monitor the on-going progress.</p> <p>g.Flooding drainage issues in Monymusk – Main flooding incident resolved as repairs done and water now flowing as it should.
