style meetings until the 30th September 2021. Thanks for everyone's support during this difficult period. Storms Arwin, Malik and Corrie hit us heavily with major damage to power and communications due to gale force winds. This was a real wake up call for all of our Communities as it demonstrated gaps in resilience backups from the main Utility Companies. Properties in Sauchen and Monymusk (especially where electricity was the only form of heating) were heavily impacted with real hardship being experienced. We outlined these messages to the Deputy First Minister and are expecting a follow up meeting soon. Sauchen Planning applications and existing infrastructure linked to road access designs were appealed against with limited outcomes. We continue to have concerns linked to potential flooding areas in the Village and to illegal landfill that is being contested currently. Foot path between Sauchen and Cluny has been a great success although we are continuing to push for a reduction in speed limits beside the Cluny School and on entering the Sauchen Village. Due to Robin & Frank's hard work traffic mirror was erected at the entrance to the Monymusk Village. Likewise the repairs to the Midmar bridge demonstrated what can be achieved by the local Community working New Planning changes (linked to the scheme of Governance) have been introduced. Thanks to Cllr Iris Walker for pushing back on key elements like the use of veto for example. Thanks to Community Council members and to Aberdeenshire Councillors who mainly attend our meetings and follow through on our issues and challenges. We had a clash in meeting dates tonight with the Aberdeenshire Local Forum also taking place so we really appreciate Cllr Iris Walker for her support. We really need more Aberdeenshire Councillors attending our meetings to support our Communities more. Financial report -Info. Judith Stokoe presented the group with an updated financial statement of accounts. This has still to be independently verified which will happen soon. Hugh Falconer has still to transfer out funds for the on-going maintenance of the local Defibrillators installed in Sauchen and Cluny. We are awaiting outstanding invoices for the bridge materials. The statement of accounts were signed off as a true statement by Richard Fyffe.
